Location: George Tubb Range, NRA Whittington Center, Raton, New Mexico, USA

General Information: There are currently 244 beds available for housing at the NRA Whittington Center. There is a Recreational Vehicle (caravan) campground that is equipped with full hookups. Additional housing is available at many motels in nearby Raton, New Mexico. Recommend that reservations be made early for the competitor housing. The center will start accepting housing reservations on February 1, 2012. These are two person rooms and sharing with other competitors is recommended. Entries: Entries must be mailed to Bald Eagles Rifle Club, Post Office Box 604, Raton, NM.

Entry Closing Date and Fees:

Advance entries are recommended. Entries close July 5, 2012 however late entries may be accepted providing they do not exceed the range capacity. Individual entry fees will be: \$100.00, fees for juniors will be \$65.00. Team match fees will be: \$80.00 for the four men Palma Team Match. Team entries must be made one hour prior to the team match. Daily fees for individuals will be \$45.00 for one day, \$80.00 for two days. Entry fees include a daily range fee of \$15.00 to the NRA Whittington Center. Those individuals not shooting the team match may get zeros at each yard line while the team match is at that yard line Cost will be \$15.00 per. shooter.

Rules: Current NRA High Power Rifle Rules shall apply.

Competitor Classifications: This is a classified match and will be conducted using the current NRA Long Range classification system in all matches. Any individual or team may elect, before firing, to compete in a higher classification than the one in which classified. Such individual or team must fire in the higher class throughout the tournament. In the event of insufficient entries in any class to warrant an award in that class individuals or teams will be moved to a higher class. International competitors without NRA USA classification will compete in the highest classification.

Rifles: Division P – The U.S. Palma Rifle, Rule 3.3.3.

Division S - Service Rifle, Rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, (.308/7.62 or .223/5.56 only).

Division F – F Class. All other rifles not falling under Division A or B and must be less than .35 caliber

Target Service: Competitors will be required to pull/mark their own targets.

Classes: High master, master, expert, sharpshooter and marksman. There must be 5 or more in a class to warrant awards.

Empty Chamber Indicator: Empty Chamber Indicators are required and must be used at all times except during preparation time and firing. ECI will be available for purchase from the stat office. The wording Empty Chamber Indicator has replaced the old wording Open Bolt Indicator. No change in the actual chamber flags.

Squadding: All matches will be squadded by the Chief Statistical Officer and will be available starting one hour prior to the start of the matches each day. Matches will start at 8 AM each day. Squadding will begin at 7:00.A.M.

Scoring: Competitors will score. Any competitor failing to perform his scoring duties may be disqualified.

Awards: Monetary awards will be given to each Match Winner and to the high individual in each Division Category/Class award group in accordance with an awards schedule which will be posted at the Statistical Office prior to the commencement of firing. Award groups must contain a minimum of 5 competitors or they will be combined with the next appropriate award group per policy. Second, third, fourth place, etc. awards will be given based on one award for each seven (7) competitors, i.e. second 8-14, third 15-21, etc..

Special Individual Awards: High Woman, Junior, Senior and Grand Senior will be awarded when 5 or more competitors are entered in those categories.

Challenge Period: The Challenge period ends 30 minutes after the posting of the match results.

Challenge Fees: Challenge fees will be \$1.00.

PRACTICE: There will be no designated practice day this year we will have a 4 man team match and an individual practice for those who don't want to shoot the team match.

Target: - NRA LR Target and NRA LRFC

MATCH 1 Saturday July 7, 2012 TEAM MATCH AND INDIVIDUAL PRACTICE.

Four man team match shooting at 800, 900, & 1000 yards. 2 sighting shots and 15 shots for score at each yard line. Time limit of 47 minutes per pair. Any one not wanting to shoot the team match can get zeros during the team match. Squading is at 7:00AM, first shot at 8:00AM.

MATCH 2

Sunday July 8, 2012

PALMA INDIVIDUAL MATCH STARTS AT 8AM.

Unlimited practice firing and 15 shots for record, at 800 yards. Coaching allowed during 800 yard practice firing only. Two sighing shots and 15 shots for record at 900 and 1000 yards prone. All practice firing and 15 shots for record must be completed within a 22 minute time limit per stage. Squading is at 7:00AM, first shot is 8:00AM.

MATCH 3

Monday July 9, 2012 - starts 8AM

Palma Individual Match

Unlimited practice firing and 15 shots for record, prone, at 800 yards. Coaching allowed during practice firing only. Two sighting shots and 15 record shots at 900 and 1000 yards prone. All practice firing and the specified 15 record shots must be completed within a 22-minute time limit per stage. Squading at 7:00AM, first shot is 8:00AM.

MATCH 4 Tuesday July 10, 2012 - STARTS AT 8AM Palma Individual Match

Unlimited practice firing and 15 shots for record, prone, at 800 yards. Coaching allowed during practice firing only. Two sighting shots and 15 record shots at 900 and 1000 yards prone. All practice firing and the specified 15 record shots must be completed within a 22-minute time limit per stage. Squading at 7:00AM, first shot is 8:00AM.

At no time is anyone to leave the firing line with a loaded rifle! All competitors are to be responsible for safe rifles while on the firing line. At no time should a competitor get out of position without the <u>Empty Chamber Indicator</u> being placed in the empty chamber and the competitor's scorekeeper verifies that fact. Penalty for breaking this rule is disqualification from the match for both the competitor and scorekeeper. Anyone that fires a shot during the preparation period will be scored a miss for the first record shot of that match. Anyone that fires a shot prior to the preparation period or any other non firing period will be disqualified from any further competition.
